in big numbers. In some cities, you can see birds, insects, cats, and mice. But sometimes it is dangerous when big animals come into cities to find food. In Cape Town in South Africa monkeys come into the city when they are hungry. They go into gardens and eat fruit and vegetables. They even go into houses and take food from cupboards and fridges! Monkeys are wild animals and they can make people scared. But the city can be dangerous for monkeys too. Sometimes, cars and buses kill monkeys in accidents.
